WHAT TO PACK LIST FOR STAFF

REQUIRED:

- **Driver's license and social security card or passport** for your tax/hiring paperwork.
- **A voided check** from your checking account for your direct deposit form. (NCSU doesn't issue checks) If you don't have a checking account, get a letter from your bank with routing instructions for your savings account. Call Keith if you have questions!
- Backpack or Daypack (handy to carry your watershoes and towel in when going to Lower Cascades)
- One week's worth of camp appropriate clothes --tank tops (not spaghetti strap or halter), t-shirts and shorts that you don't mind getting dirty. Pants that sag and shirts that show your belly are inappropriate for camp, also clothes with drug/alcohol/smoking or other inappropriate content are not to be worn while camp is in session. (camp has a washer & dryer and provides washing soap)
- Long pants/jeans
- Sweatshirt or jacket for when it rains and/or gets cold
- Tennis shoes/hiking boots--remember that your shoes will be getting dirty, so don't bring your best pair to wear every day
- An extra pair of shoes (in case the first gets wet while crossing a creek)
- A pair of water shoes with an ankle strap for when we go creek stomping (not flip flops)
- Sleeping bag (for camp outs under the stars)
- Toiletries (toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, shampoo, brush/comb)
- Sunscreen & Insect repellent
- An outfit for the Thursday night dance and staff dinner
- Camp appropriated sleepwear/pajamas
- Swimsuits --these should be camp appropriate i.e. one-pieces for girls and trunks for guys
- Beach towel, towels and washcloths
- Bedding (single/twin sheets, comforter, pillows)
- Prescribed medicine in their original labeled container. All medication will be stored in the infirmary on the 2nd floor of the hotel.
- Alarm Clock and watch (gotta get to flag raising on time!)
- Flashlight

RECOMMENDED:

- Shower shoes
- Digital Camera (for digital scavenger hunt)
- Camp store money
- Items to decorate your cabin
- Fan (The cabins normally have 2 each)
- Bathrobe
- Room Rug
- Radio/CD/IPOD player with music appropriate for young listeners
- Musical Instruments
- Canteen with carry strap (for hiking to the lost cabin)

NOT ALLOWED AT CAMP:

- Knives, or weapons of any kind (Unless it's a bow for the archery course)
